** REMINDERS **

- Don't forget to obtain a building permit for any structure you plan to build, alter, or change prior to the commencement of the project. Pick up at City Office.
- Reservations for the main shelter house at Centennial Park can be made through the City Office for the upcoming season (725-2371).
- Be a responsible pet owner: Keep your animals leashed and on your own property. When walking your pets, respect others' property by picking up the "deposits" they may leave along the way.
- For dogs found running at large please call Sioux County Law Enforcement (737-2280) to report dogs running at large within the community or on your property.
- Property Clean-Up: Please assess your property for compliance.

Dumping of Grass/Leaves/Tree Branches

The City will again be offering free dumping of grass clippings, leaves, and tree branches to the west of the City Shed (north end of Main St.). The bins are clearly marked so please dump accordingly. **Do not leave plastic garbage bags with grass/leaves.**

- Dumping of grass and leaves onto city streets is strictly prohibited by City Code.
- The City does **not** pick up branches off of private property unless they are a result of storm damage. Otherwise, property owners are responsible for hauling their own branches to the dumping site at the City Shed.
- If you are having large trees or limbs removed by a professional at your property, the City will open the Tree Dump on the south side of town for the contractor. Please contact the City Office with questions.

SPRING CITY WIDE CLEANUP

April 22, 2020

Boyden residents must purchase a \$10 Lawn Flag (one for each household) at the Boyden City Office or O.C. Sanitation Office (710 Ohio Ave SW, Orange City).

- Workers will only remove those items with the special lawn flag clearly displayed.

Allowable items: garbage and home items, furniture/wood items, and mattresses/carpets.

Non-allowable items: all appliances/white goods, TV's, building - remodeling materials, wood chips, auto parts (tires, batteries, etc.), concrete, steel/iron, yard waste, tree branches, oil, yard chemicals, or wet paints.



Special Pick-Up arrangements available with O.C. Sanitation Office: (712)737-2645

Will NOT collect:

Fires, Batteries, Concrete, Paint, Steel, Iron, Yard Waste, House or Lawn Chemicals, or Construction/Shingles.

ALL Electronics need prior approval: TV's, All Computer Components (printers, monitors, keyboards, mouse(s), and CPU's, etc.).

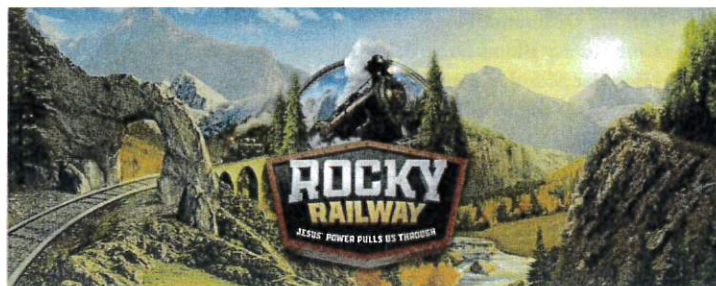
White Goods that require an extra fee and prior approval: Stoves, Water heaters, Washer/Dryer, Microwaves, Humidifier/Dehumidifiers, Air Conditioners, Refrigerators/Freezers.

If you have any "White Goods" or Electronics to get rid of, you need to call OC Sanitation (712-737-2645) prior to clean up day, to have it scheduled and paid for in advance.
