## \*\*REMINDERS\*\*

### **Dumping of Grass/Leaves/Tree Branches**

The City will again be offering free dumping of grass clippings, leaves, and tree branches to the west of the City Shed (north end of Main St.). The bins are clearly marked so please dump accordingly. **Do not leave plastic garbage bags with grass/leaves.** 

- Dumping of grass and leaves onto city streets is strictly prohibited by City Code.
- The City does <u>not</u> pick up branches off of private property unless they are a result of storm damage. Otherwise, property owners are responsible for hauling their own branches to the dumping site at the City Shed.
- If you are having large trees or limbs removed by a professional at your property, the City will open the Tree Dump on the south side of town for the contractor. Please contact the City Office with questions.

For all items below please contact NW IOWA LANDFILL at (712) 324 – 4026 to get options for proper disposal.






