#### BASEBALL & SOFTBALL INFORMATION

<u>WHO</u>: lst-6th grade (past school year) Boyden & surrounding area kids are invited to participate in the Boyden Summer Baseball & Softball Leagues. Teams are divided into 1st-2nd graders, 3rd-4th graders, and 5th-6th graders. Team divisions may change depending on the registration numbers.

**WHAT:** During Summer REC Baseball and Softball, kids will have the opportunity to practice with same-aged peers in developing teamwork, leadership, and baseball/softball skills and abilities.

**WHEN:** Practices will begin toward the end of May, and games will begin in June. As the season gets going, coaches will aim to have approximately 2 games per week (per age group), though this may be adjusted depending on weather and other teams' availability. Specific information about practice and game times will be communicated at the beginning of the season by the teams' coaches.

**WHERE:** Games will occur in Boyden and in surrounding area towns. Practices will be in Boyden.

**WHY:** To get kids involved in fun and meaningful activities that support growth, positivity, and skill development!

#### BOYDEN JR. LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

If your child wishes to participate in the Boyden Summer Baseball or Softball League, your family will also be responsible for helping serve one 'duty' during he Boyden Tournament or for finding a replacement party to cover your shift. The 2024 Boyden Tournament will take place the weekend of <u>June 14–15</u>. Duties may include serving concessions, umping, announcing, or facilitating other tournament needs.
