***City Dump.** Plastic garbage bags and cardboard are not allowed in the city dump. Please empty your compost and personally dispose of containers.

***Don't forget to obtain a building permit** for any structure you plan to build, alter, or change prior to the commencement of the project. Pick up at City Office.

***Be a responsible pet owner:** Keep your animals leashed and on your own property. When walking your pets, respect others' property by picking up the "deposits" they may leave along the way.



***For dogs found running at large** please call Sioux County Law Enforcement (737-2280) to report dogs running at large within the community or on your property.
