June 12, 2023

Mayor Laryl Koerselman called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Council members present were Robing Jungers, Bob Koerselman, and Austin Loges. Nathan Alexander and Stacie Damstra were absent.

Maintenance Report -

A discussion was had regarding making improvements to the city shed. This will be something at a future discussion. Council discussed removing the rough concrete in the approach at the city grass/tree dump and replacing with crushed concrete. The city will get costs for putting a pickleball court at the Centennial Park and review at the next meeting.

Consent Agenda -B. Koerselman made a motion for approval of the bills in the amount of \$196,738.02, the May financials, the May 8 & 18 minutes, the liquor license for Roks Foods and Brew, and the building permits for Aiko Kamies and Wade Haarsma. Loges support. Motion carried 3-0.

Council reviewed the proposal from Williams & Company for the annual examination. The city will compare the prices with previous years as well as compare pricing with other firms. We will review again at the July meeting.

A discussion was had regarding the progress of the Prairie/Grant Street Project. Tami gave an update on the status of the project and the preconstruction meeting held with Boer & Sons. Council reviewed the Agreement for Professional Services from DGR Engineering. Jungers made a motion that the city enter into the agreement. B. Koerselman support. Motion carried 3-0. Council also discussed a request for a resident to run their gutters into the tile that runs along the street. Loges made a motion that if the tile is a moisture pulling tile (such as a field tile) that we would not allow for this, but if the gutters could run in to the storm drain, upon engineers' approval and that it is at the homeowner's expense, this would be allowed. B. Koerselman support the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

With no further business B. Koerselman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Loges support. Motion carried 3-0. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
