Minutes of Monthly Council Meeting

July 11, 2022

Mayor Pro-tem Robin Jungers called the meeting to order at 5:27 p.m.

Council members present were Stacie Damstra, Austin Loges, Bob Koerselman and Nathan Alexander.

Others present were Deb Moret and city employees Tami Kamies, Heath Hilbrands, and Jerry Lode.

Deb Moret presented to council concerns she has regarding her privacy. A brief discussion was had with the council. Deb left the meeting at 5:50pm.

Maintenance Report – Jerry reported that the new John Deere mower is set to be delivered in early August. The plan will be to trade in the Ex-Mark mower at that time. We will continue to try to get quotes on redoing the exterior of the Demco Center. We will discuss this at a later meeting. A discussion was had regarding trees at the park that will need to be removed because they are dead. Council agreed that we will remove 4 trees this fall/winter and plant new ones. We will re-evaluate again next year the need to remove additional trees. A discussion was also had regarding all the trees in the right of way in the town. The city will review whether or not to consider starting to remove the trees from the right of way to avoid possible damages in a severe storm.

Consent Agenda -B. Koerselman made a motion for approval of the bills in the amount of \$123,488.25, the June financials, the June 8 & 15 minutes, the building permit for Austin Loges, and the Water Purchase Contract with Lyon & Sioux Rural Water. Alexander support. Motion carried 4-0.

Alexander made a motion to pass Resolution 2022-13 authorizing the transfers done between funds in Fiscal Year 2022. Loges support. Motion carried 4-0.

A discussion was had regarding the Prairie Street/Grant Street project. B. Koerselman made a motion that we will move forward with the project but will wait until the Spring of 2023 to proceed. Tami will check with DGR on projected timeline of project moving forward. Alexander support. Motion carried 4-0.

Councilman Alexander had a brief discussion regarding a concept plan of the Centennial Park. We will proceed with getting pricing and ideas on improving our park. We will have further discussions on this matter at later meetings.

With no further discussion Alexander made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Damstra support. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned 7:40 p.m.
