Maintenance Report - Cody gave a brief update to council on the city's sewer compliance status. The limits have been good. We will need to remain under the limit for this compliance schedule until June. SIG's BOD limits and rates have been in line. The lagoon system is holding good. Council reviewed the quote for putting gutters on the city/library building. Jungers made a motion to approve the quote to have gutters put on the building. Loges support. Motion carried. 3-0. A discussion was had regarding the X-Mark Mower. Council will hold off on any decision until further discussion can be had with Jerry and Tami.

Consent Agenda -Jungers made a motion for approval of the bills in the amount of \$62,993.51, the August financials, the August 8 minutes, and the building permit for Clark Moret. Damstra support. Motion carried 3-0.

A discussion was had regarding the city purchasing the existing fire department building. The Boyden Area Fire Board accepted the offer of \$100,000 from the city for the purchase. The city will pay for any fees associated with the transaction for the purchase.

Proposed changes to the dog ordinance were reviewed by council. Damstra made a motion that the city move forward with changing the city ordinance to reflect the proposed changes. Loges support. Motion carried 4-0.

Councilman Alexander made a motion to waive the first and second reading and to approve the Ordinance 2022-103 Amending sections 75.05 and 75.06 and 77.02 (All-Terrain Vehicles and Golf Carts). Loges support. Roll call vote: 4-0

Council reviewed the plans regarding the park concept. This was a planning discussion regarding the potential for future park expansion.

With no further discussion Alexander made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Jungers support. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned 6:33 p.m.
